## 1. European Citizenship

- CE as a value-based organization
- which strives for meaningful student mobility
- as a way to bring about European Citizenship
- and that cherishes the vision of students and universities being transformative societal agents



## 2. Enabling language learning

- language plays a vital role in enabling access to foreign cultures and societies
- language should not be a barrier to diverse mobility flows
- CE puts a great deal of emphasis in enabling language learning, both online and through intensive courses



### **3. Extended stays abroad**

- Campus Europae exchanges last two semesters
- and students are encouraged to spend a second year abroad
- the length of the stay abroad plays a pivotal role in enabling language learning and thus enhancing immersion in the host society
- rendering the experience far more meaningful than if measured in a few weeks or months

## 4. Improving academic recognition

- academic recognition is one of Erasmus main problems
- CE academic committees show that intensive cooperation among HEI's can significantly decrease the incidence of such problems

- combining study and working abroad
- advancing the social dimension of the EHEI
